Paper submissions and the peer review process will be managed through the "EasyChair" platform (here is the link for submissions). The authors can choose among four thematic areas: "Life Styles", "Environment", "Territory" and "Wine". International experts have been invited and they have agreed to coordinate the sessions.

Awards

A 7 days holiday in a typical tuscan agritourism is the special prize given by the Editorial Scientific Committee to the best paper for each session.

Proceedings

The proceedings will be published by Elsevier in their Agriculture and Agricultural Science Procedia collection.

Furthermore, authors of selected papers, chosen by the Editorial Scientific board, will be invited to submit extended versions for possible inclusion (after a further peer review) in international journals.

The Journals that have promoted this initiative are "Review of Studies on Sustainability", "Wine Economics and Policy" and "Aestimum". Other International Journals have joined the initiative.
